



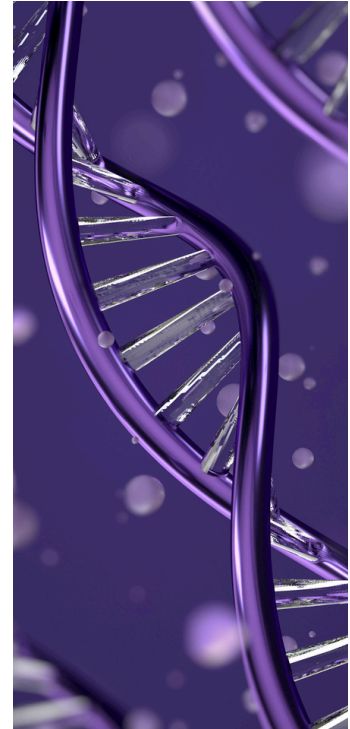

What is SATB2-Associated Syndrome

SATB2-Associated Syndrome (aka Glass Syndrome) is caused by problems in the SATB2 gene located on chromosome 2q33.1, which is a neurodevelopmental disorder. SAS affects the individuals through global developmental delays.

Most significant is the absence of speech, or significantly delayed/affected speech. We often see palate abnormalities – including cleft palate or high arched palate. Other key characteristics of SAS are dental issues – missing adult teeth and/or oversized front teeth; low bone density, and behavioral issues. We are seeing a growing number of our patients with seizures and sleep difficulties.

2026 Family and Medical Conference July 22-24 in Oklahoma City, OK

The biennial SATB2-Associated Syndrome Family and Medical Conference unites families for two days of workshops and networking. It brings together researchers, parents, and patients to enhance understanding of SAS and support the community. The event includes educational sessions, social activities, and programming for children and siblings, promoting hope, collaboration, and belonging within the SATB2 community.

Over 275 attendees, including 70 families, are expected at this year's conference in Oklahoma City. Families will learn about scientific advancements from top clinicians and researchers and participate in care and advocacy workshops. The conference also offers a supportive environment for parents and caregivers to connect, share stories, and find strength together.

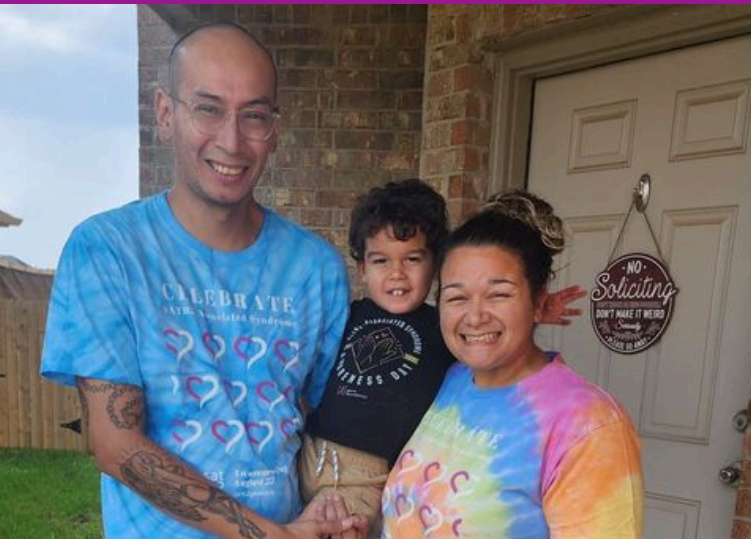
